



Dear Fellow Exhibitors:

The Brazilian Association for Aerosol Research (BAAR) invites you to participate and exhibit at the 2011 Conference, which will be held August 1 to 5, at the Center for Technology and Science (CTC) at the Pontifical Catholic University at Rio de Janeiro (PUC-Rio), Brazil. This is the 2nd BAAR meeting, and we anticipate 100 to 150 attendees.

Take the opportunity to learn the latest advances across the spectrum of aerosol research. There will be numerous networking opportunities of which you can take advantage in a country that has a fast growing economy, and is making significant investments in science and engineering. Academia, government, and industry researchers will have a vital role in this conference.

Exhibit booths will be located in the entrance hall of the Pe. Achieta Auditorium where most of the social events, including session breaks, and poster sessions will be held. Your booth fee includes four days of exhibition, beginning Monday morning and ending late Thursday afternoon. The Exhibitors' Reception is planned for Tuesday evening, in the Deans reception area, located in the 11<sup>th</sup> floor of CTC.

Monday through Thursday will begin with a general session at 8:00 AM followed by the exhibit hall opening at 9:00 AM for a coffee break. There will be two (2) major poster sessions. The Exhibitors' Reception will be held on Tuesday evening and will offer substantial opportunities for networking in addition to light food and beverages.

Please see the schedule on page 2 which lists the Conference timing in more detail. You will notice that set-up is scheduled during the **morning** on Monday, August 1<sup>st</sup>. This will allow you the flexibility of arriving in Rio on Sunday for a tour **Ipanema Beach**, the **Sugar Loaf**, and the **Christ of the Corcovado** in the "Cidade Maravilhosa" as Rio de Janeiro is known in Brazil.

An ELECTRONIC Final Conference program, with attendee list and Biographical Sketch of 22 invited plenary speakers from the US and Brazil, recorded on Pen Drives, will be provided to all Conference attendants at the registration desk upon arrival at the Conference. **BOOTH ASSIGNMENT**

Priority for booth assignment will be made on a first-come, first-served basis upon receipt of application and payment. Management reserves the right to make any revisions necessary to the floor plan illustrated bellow.





## **CONTRACT FOR SPACE**

All contracts are subject to the rules and regulations herein given. All applications must be accompanied by payment to cover the total cost of the space requested. Booth locations will be assigned when full payment is received. A refund of 50% of fees paid by the exhibitor will be returned in the event of cancellation by written notice to the exhibit manager. **No refund of any fees will be made if notice is received after Friday, July 29, 2011.**

No exhibitor shall assign, sublet, or apportion the whole or any part of the space allotted, nor exhibit therein, nor permit any other party to exhibit therein, any other goods than those manufactured or handled by the exhibitor in the regular course of their business, nor permit any representative or firm or company not exhibiting to solicit business or take orders in their space. BAAR reserves the right to remove any exhibitor, its assignees, or subletters in the event that the exhibitor and/or representatives violate any of these provisions.

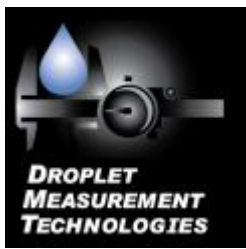
